Please note that all students are required to read three (3) of the selections listed for the grade they will be entering in September. Students will be assigned projects from the Summer Reading list in September 2011.

Students entering Grades 3-8:

For the books read, students are to complete the following information in a **handwritten, outline format**:

1. **Title**
2. **Author**
3. **Genre** (type of book such as realistic fiction, mystery, fantasy, etc.)
4. **Setting** (time and place)
5. **Main Characters**
6. **Plot Summary:** In paragraph form, write 8-10 sentences explaining in your own words what the book is about. Include the conflict (problem and solution) in your summary.
7. **Personal Thoughts:** Your opinion of the book and why you did or did not like the book.

Book reports and activities are due in school on Friday, September 9, 2011.

Remember to be neat and to have your name on all papers and activities handed in.
