## SCHOOL SUPPLIES for 2017 - 2018 SCHOOL YEAR

Dear Parents:

The School Supply List is provided for you as a reference to take advantage of the “summer” shopping sales. At various times during the year, teachers may request additional items. If an item or color cannot be found, you may substitute. It is not necessary for your child to bring in all supplies at one time; for example, 4 glue sticks or 3 packs of loose-leaf paper. Use your own judgment.

### PLEASE NOTE:

- LABEL everything, including school uniform, with child’s FIRST and LAST NAME (use permanent marker).
- Students are allowed to bring in a WATER BOTTLE -- label with child's first and last name (use permanent marker.)
- **SCHOOL TABLET** (Laurel Paper): \$2.00 each, purchased from School Book Store. (*All students receive first tablet FREE.*)
- **Grades 1-8: ASSIGNMENT BOOK (Agenda):** will be issued to students.
